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Growing Young Leaders...

- Is a course for young people about what it means to be a Christian leader and how that impacts leadership situations.
- Is beneficial for developing young people who demonstrate leadership qualities or have leadership potential.
- Meets monthly - there are 5 evening sessions involving discussion and activities (6-8pm with food provided). Plus 2 full day modules and 1 residential weekend.
- Adult mentors meet with their young person once a month to help them think and reflect on their learning and help them start applying it.
- Incorporates some simple project work such as interviewing a church leader.



What do churches need to do?

- Identify young people (ages 14-17) with leadership potential.
- Ensure the church leadership team are committed to supporting them by giving opportunities within the church.
- Identify an individual mentor (ideally not the youth leader) who will attend a mentor training evening and support the young person throughout the course.
- Register young people on the course.
